

CHRISTMAS SCOTTIE CARD

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Sally Poole - Independent Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

All of the measurements for this project can be found on page 2.

Please read through the instructions before beginning.

- Stamp the Scottie dog in black ink on to Basic White cardstock and then punch it out with the Scottie Dog Punch.
- Stamp the sentiment in black ink on Basic White cardstock and cut it out using a banner die from the **Stylish Shapes Dies** set. I used the die that is approximately 2 3/8" x 1", but I actually made it wider to fit the sentiment shown. Set these aside.
- Adhere the Designer Series Paper piece (3 1/8" x 5 1/8") to the Basic Black piece. (3 1/4" x 5 1/4")
- Adhere the Basic Black piece and DSP combo from step 1 to the Cherry Cobbler card base.
- Next, adhere the Basic White square (2 3/8") to the Basic Black square (2 3/4"). These squares were cut out using the two largest square dies from the **Stylish Shapes Dies** set.
- Apply liquid glue to the bottom 2/3 of the black & white squares combo and attach it to the card. You can use other adhesives but you will most likely need to move the squares combo around a bit. **Make sure the distance from the base of the card to the top of the black & white squares combo is not greater than 4 1/4" or you'll have trouble getting the completed card into an envelope.**
- Pop the Scottie dog up on Dimensionals and add it to the card.
- Adhere the 5 1/8" x 1/2" Cherry Cobbler strip to the lower portion of the card and adhere the sentiment to it.
- I added a bow made from 1/8" ribbon and an Adhesive Backed Snowflake. (Retired.) And there you have it!
