Cardstock pieces:

2 "tote" die cuts from Designer Series Paper. (I used Bloom Impressions.)

2 "bottom tote" die cuts from Cinnamon Cider cardstock.

4 "side trim" die cuts from Cinnamon Cider cardstock.

1 "scarf/tie" die cut from Designer Series Paper. (I used Bloom Impressions – reverse side of first piece.)

4 "handle" die cuts from Cinnamon Cider cardstock.

Other Supplies:

NOTES & TOTES die set.

Adhesive. (I used Tombow glue.)

Optional: Needle nose pliers are very helpful. You can also use long tweezers or your fingers!

Reverse tweezers are also helpful.





Row 1 – Left to Right:

Floral Delight & Cinnamon Cider, Pattern Party & Cinnamon Cider, Botanical Butterfly & Pretty in Pink, Florals in Bloom & Cinnamon Cider, and Delightfully Eclectic & Bubble Bath.

Row 2 – Left to Right:

Delightfully Eclectic & Pretty Peacock, Everyday Happiness & Gray Granite, Delightfully Eclectic & Crumb Cake, Bloom Impressions & Melon Mambo, and Wildly Flowering & Basic White.

Row 3 – Left to Right:

Wildly Flowering & Moody Mauve, Botanical Butterfly & Basic Black, Regal Winter & Cinnamon Cider, Bloom Impressions & Cinnamon Cider, and Pattern Party & Poppy Parade.
